Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) is a Psychological technique for analysing and modifying behaviours in a wide range of situations. Pivotal Response Treatment (PRT) is the most effective and least costly method of delivering ABA therapy to children with Autism.

WHY Pivotal Response Treatment (PRT).

- PRT is an ABA technique developed at the University of California at Santa Barbara, to overcome the many shortcomings of Discrete Trial Learning (DTL) and to be more naturalistic.
- Based on the principles of ABA and DTL, PRT was developed to be less rigid, involve more “natural learning”. It is more enjoyable for the child, parent or therapist and produces faster changes in Autism.
- PRT has been extensively researched and validated, with over 200 journal articles and books published to-date.
- PRT promotes attention, motivation, language, social play, empathy and generalisation of learned skills to other areas of functioning. More at <http://www.autism.net.au>
