Psychological assessments

All assessments are conducted by a registered psychologist, with a clinical psychologist's involvement where appropriate. Our approach is aligned with DSM-5-TR criteria and current Australian clinical guidelines.

Reports are structured to provide clear diagnostic impressions where applicable, along with clinically relevant recommendations to support ongoing care and decision-making.

Why refer to BNC?

We have been providing psychological and behavioural assessments since 2000. **MHCPs are welcomed.**

Our reports are written with the needs of the referring practitioner in mind: concise, clinically grounded, and designed to support practical decision-making.

Patients are offered a feedback session to discuss outcomes, and a comprehensive written report is provided to both the patient and referring GP.

Telehealth is available to facilitate the process.

Examples of our assessment process

ADHD assessments are conducted in line with current Australian Clinical Guidelines and include clinical interviews, developmental history, standardised rating scales and screening for co-morbidities.

Autism assessments are aligned with the Autism CRC National Guidelines (2023) and include clinical interview, developmental history, behavioural observation, and standardised assessment tools. If indicated, we help with NDIS access requirements.

Case Formulations and diagnostic conclusions for all assessments are based on DSM-5-TR criteria, with tailored recommendations for ongoing support.
